



Dr. K. V. Sarma is a distinguished scientist, thought leader, and visionary who bridges the gap between modern scientific inquiry and ancient wisdom. A Ph.D. in Chemical Sciences in Europe serves as the foundation for Dr. Sarma's 15-year career in the international Chemical Sciences, a trajectory that includes distinguished postdoctoral research at the CNRS, France, and a series of high-impact leadership roles within the global pharmaceutical sector.

Following the tragic loss of his mother to cancer, Dr. Sarma experienced a profound shift in focus. Driven by this personal mission, he pivoted from the established pharmaceutical landscape to investigate the root causes of illness, integrating his rigorous scientific expertise with holistic approaches to cancer prevention and long-term health.

Convinced that over 90% of cancers are sporadic and preventable, he has dedicated more than a decade to researching "What Actually Causes Cancer." His contributions were recognized by CancerRadio, USA, in 2013 and by the Advanced Center for Treatment, Research and Education in Cancer (ACTREC), Tata Memorial Hospital, Mumbai, in 2014. His research led to a landmark proposal for a ₹1,000-crore integrated Public Health Center (PHC) system to revolutionize preventive care in India.

Dr. Sarma's career is marked by a rare blend of rigorous scientific inquiry and a deep-seated commitment to human potential, earning him inclusion in the Empire Who's Who Registry of Executives and Professionals. As a prolific author, he has produced an extensive body of work that bridges ancient traditions with modern leadership. His recent titles include *The Mandala of Skill – The 64 Arts of Completeness* (2026), *Sanatana Karma – The Thought Leader* (2026), and *Summa Iru – The Foundation to Steadfastness/Equanimity* (2026). In his influential publication *Who is Krishna Bhagavan* (2025), he redefines the four Varnas as essential, internal qualities that every human must cultivate for an integrated life. This research was published in the multidisciplinary peer-reviewed research journal *Vedic Science* in both India and the USA. His other works include *Kadali Tharangaalu* (2025) and the foundational e-book *Quality of Life by Design* (2016).
